# Introduction

Education is the basic foundation for human development in any society. The ability of a society to build the capacity of its human resource is a major indicator for the quality of its development. Nigeria, the most populous Black Country in the world is suffering a major crisis in its public education system. Years of military dictatorship and maladministration have had adverse effects on the educational system-neglect and underfunding being the crux of the issues faced by this sector. From elementary to tertiary institutions, these schools face basic infrastructural and manpower challenges: Lack of classrooms, furniture, books, equipment, electricity, water, instructors and support services. The decline in the quality of graduates produced each year and the poor performance of students in standard examinations can be traced back to the lack of these basic needs. Nigeria has one of the fastest growing populations in the world and is ill-equipped at its current status to deal with the deluge of manpower's educational needs that will confront it in several years from now. The Rescue Educational Foundation is an organization founded on the urgent need to remedy the decay in public education in Nigeria.

## **Rescue Educational Foundation**

Rescue Educational Foundation is a non-profit, non-governmental organization established in with the primary vision of developing the public educational system in Nigeria by providing policy, infrastructural, funding and manpower support. The organization is enthused to provide an educational environment, conducive for Nigerian children, a large proportion of which are in public schools.

Rescue Educational Foundation is established as a vehicle through which individuals, corporate organizations, and community-based organizations can deal with the menace in the public school system in Nigeria through strategic partnership.

Rescue Educational Foundation was established in 2007 and commenced operations in January 2008.

- 3. Partner with individuals, corporate organizations, religious bodies and other community-based organizations in the provision of infrastructures and learning materials e.g. furniture, water, textbooks, notebooks for public schools.
- 4. Promote public-private partnership for public schools for project sustainability and to facilitate proper management of infrastructures
- 5. Encourage reading culture among children in public schools by developing local libraries and resource centers
- 6. Encourage individuals to give back to the public schools through sponsorships and special programs e.g. Scholarships, Volunteer Teaching Corps, Mentoring and Counseling etc.
- 7. Seek funding support from international donor organizations both in Nigeria and in Diaspora to execute projects
- 8. Work with public school teachers' governing bodies to facilitate the provision of quality teaching staff in public schools and encourage better compensation for teachers
